

- Who? YOU! Beginners, Intermediate, and Advanced Players
- What? **American Mahjong** (playing the current NMJL game card) with 3 to 4 players per table. **Siamese Mahjong** (playing the current NMJL game card or Siamese Mahjong card) with 2 (or 4) players per table. With 3 players, there is no Charleston unless the table votes for one. In Siamese Mahjong, you play with double tiles, there is no Charleston, and you must have two Mahjong's to win a game.
- When? Wednesdays starting at 12:30pm to approx. 3:30pm. (And no, you don't have to stay the whole time); **NOTE FOR BEGINNERS**: If you've never played before or need a refresher, please register for a Mahjong 101 Class (free) offered at the Harmony Center on the first Monday of each month beginning August 5, 2024 from 9am to noon. You must register for Mahj 101 online (see link below), on the group's Facebook page, or by calling/texting Cyndi at 909/241-2690.
- Where? The **Harmony Center located at 223 Hudon Road, Sequim, WA**
*NOTE: Please **do not park** in the paved driveway as this is reserved for the homeowners. Parking is available next to the large garage on the right of the driveway, and in the gravel areas.*
